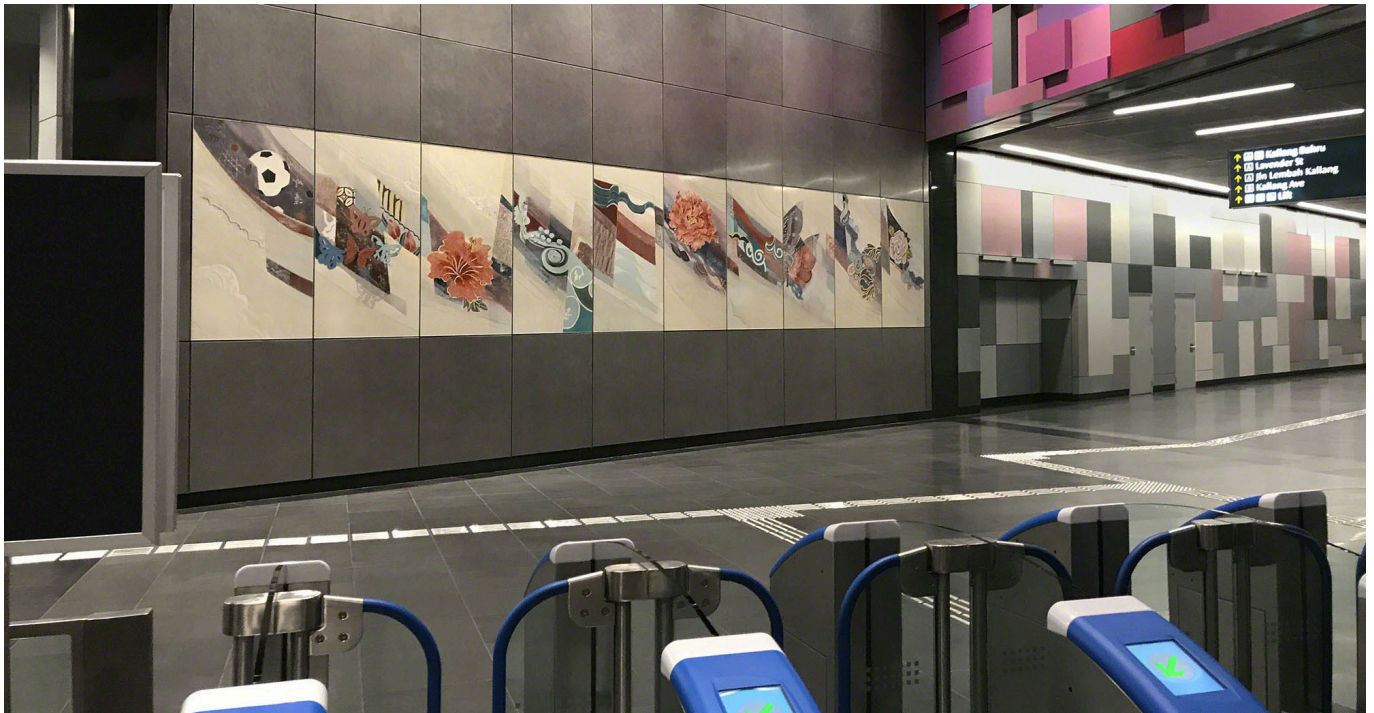


Bendemeer Station – Downtown Line 3

Singapore's Land Transport Authority designated the renovation of six stations, including the Bendemeer Station, as part of its innovative program, "Art in Transit" (AIT). This program sought to transform some of Singapore's popular metro stations with inspiring art from local artists. Unique to this station, a vibrant piece of artwork titled "And a New World" created by Christine Chang Hoei spans across eight [CeramicSteel panels](#). Inspired by the surrounding city's history, architecture, colors and patterns, Hoei incorporated these elements in her masterpiece of five petalled Hibiscus, conveying the meaning of joy and celebration. Additionally, the inclusion of French lace signified the European influence in the nearby Jalan Besar area, with the meaning of delicacy and refinement. Hoei's unique portrayal required a material such as CeramicSteel that showcases the detail in the artwork and can withstand the constant activity in this station.
